

Thanks to a contribution in memory of Henry and Marguerite Wyman by their family, and to the generosity of all our patrons, finalists who do not place or are not given encouragement awards will each receive additional stipends of \$1,000.

In November 2020, we lost one of our fervent supporters, Irene Nichols, an Emeritus Professor of Psychology in Education at Northeastern University. She started attending the auditions in 1985 and heard many of our finalists who went on to major careers. In 2016, at her suggestion, we established a Legacy Fund for donors to designate an annual or one-time encouragement award for someone special and also to fund student tickets. In 2016, the first Philip R. Nichols Encouragement award was granted. Recently we were informed by Irene's estate of a very generous endowment to support this award annually -- guaranteeing that Irene Nichols' support of singers will be her lasting legacy.

BRADY WALSH is Associate Director of the Metropolitan Opera Laffont Competition. He is also owner and Artistic Director of Carpe Diem Theater, an innovative summer program for aspiring young performers in grades K-12. Mr. Walsh judges for the Met throughout the United States, Canada, and Mexico, presents master classes, and hears young artists in screening auditions both at the Met and at various summer festivals across the country. After successfully pivoting to virtual auditions for the Met Competition's 2020-2021 season, Mr. Walsh was brought on as a producer for the 2021 Queen Sonja International Music Competition, as well as for the University of Cincinnati College Conservatory of Music's Corbett Competition. In 2019, he was named a special guest for the finals of the inaugural Nicola Martinucci International Vocal Competition in Lucca, Italy, and was a technician at the 2020 NATS National Conference in New York, where he co-presented with Melissa Wegner their workshop "The Self-Assured Singer," also seen at SUNY Potsdam.



SUSAN SHIPLETT ASHBAKER, Associate Professor/Director of Westminster Opera Theatre for Westminster Choir College at Rider University and Director for the CoOPERAtive Program at Westminster, brings over 35 years of experience in the performing arts. Ms. Ashbaker is active in the opera/vocal world as an independent artistic advisor/consultant, master class presenter, lecturer and opera/vocal coach. She is in demand as a master class presenter, having taught recently at Boston Conservatory, University of Miami, Binghamton University and Ithaca College, among others. Ms. Ashbaker was affiliated with Tri-Cities Opera for five years; four as General and Artistic Director, and one as Artistic Director. Additionally, Ms. Ashbaker served Opera Company of Philadelphia (OCP) for 16 years, the last 11 as director of artistic and music administration. She is a frequent judge for the Metropolitan Opera National Council Auditions and former participant on the MET Opera Quiz.



TED TAYLOR. Equally at home in the pit conducting a repertoire of over 55 operas and musicals, on the stage accompanying some of the world's pre-eminent vocalists or appearing in the country's top cabaret venues, Ted Taylor enjoys a varied international career. As pianist he has appeared on four continents with such luminaries as Kathleen Battle, Sylvia McNair and Ben Heppner.

Maestro Taylor has served on the conducting staffs of the Metropolitan Opera and Lyric Opera of Chicago and has led performances for many American opera companies, including Cincinnati Opera, Atlanta Opera, Wolf Trap Opera, and New York City Opera, where he debuted conducting *La Traviata*. A seasoned MONC judge, for four consecutive years he coached and played the Met National Council Semifinals and Grand Finals concerts of what is now the Laffont Competition.

Maestro Taylor is currently in his fifteenth year on the faculty of Yale University and his twenty-fourth at Mannes School of Music in New York City, where he coaches and teaches.



DAMIEN KRZYZEK, pianist, holds faculty positions at the New England Conservatory and the Boston Conservatory. As a member of NEC's collaborative piano department, he educates young pianists in the art of playing operatic literature and coaching singers. Since 2008 he has served on the music staff at Opera Theatre of Saint Louis. Before devoting himself to collaborative piano, Mr. Krzyzek studied as a baritone in his native Denver, where he was a regional MONC finalist in 2004. An artist member of Music for Food, **he will be performing an evening of piano trios** with violinist Natalie Lin Douglas and cellist Jamie Clark at the Theodore Parker Unitarian Universalist Church in West Roxbury at 7:30pm on March 5th. All proceeds from the concert will benefit the Roslindale Food Pantry.
