#### 2024 New England Laffont Competition Judges



**Denyce Graves**, mezzo-soprano, has thrilled audiences worldwide in title roles in *Carmen* and *Samson et Dalila* – signature performances that have taken her to the Metropolitan Opera, Vienna Staatsoper, Royal Opera House, Covent Garden, San Francisco Opera, Opéra National de Paris, Lyric Opera of Chicago, Washington National Opera, Bayerische Staatsoper, Arena di Verona, Deutsche Oper Berlin, Opernhaus Zürich, Teatro Real in Madrid, Houston Grand Opera, Dallas Opera, Teatro Colón in Buenos Aires, Los Angeles Opera, and the Festival Maggio Musicale in Florence. Her many other notable appearances include the world premieres of Douglas J. Cuomo's *Doubt* at Minnesota Opera and Terence Blanchard's *Champion* at Opera Theatre of St. Louis, as well as role debuts of Katisha in *The Mikado* at Lyric Opera of Kansas

City and Herodias in *Salome* at Palm Beach Opera. In the 2021-2022 season, she returned to the Metropolitan Opera as Maria in *Porgy and Bess* and on the concert stage in the 2021 season-opening performance of Mahler's Symphony No. 2 *Resurrection*. As a solo recitalist, she has performed at Ithaca College, Lawrence University, and the Clarkesville Concert Artist Series. In 2022, she made her directorial debut in a new production of *Carmen* at Minnesota Opera and the Glimmerglass Festival.



Christopher Cano is Director of the Cafritz Young Artists and the American Opera Initiative of Washington National Opera at The Kennedy Center. He previously held positions of Head of Music and Director of Artistic Operations of Arizona Opera's Marion Roose Pullin Opera Studio between 2017-2022. Cano is a recitalist, orchestra soloist, and collaborative pianist who has performed throughout the U.S., Mexico, Israel, Europe, and Asia. He is a coach who has prepared vocalists for appearances at the Metropolitan Opera, Teatro alla Scala, Chicago Lyric Opera, and orchestral appearances with the New York Philharmonic, San Francisco Symphony, Chicago Symphony Orchestra, London Symphony Orchestra, and Berlin Philharmonic among others.



Melissa Wegner is the Executive Director of the Metropolitan Opera's Lindemann Young Artist Development Program and the Laffont Competition. She is responsible for identifying, awarding, and developing the world's most promising operatic talent. A member of the Met's Artistic staff since 2011, she was the casting consultant for the recent opera *Intimate Apparel* at Lincoln Center Theater. In addition to the District, Regional and National rounds of the Laffont Competition, Ms. Wegner has adjudicated international competitions including the Belvedere Competition (South Africa, Russia, Latvia), Opera's Golden Voice (Georgia), the Nicola Martinucci Competition (Italy). US Competitions include the SAI Vocal Competition, the McCammon Voice Competition, and NATSAA Competition. A faculty member of Ravinia's Steans

Music Institute, Ms. Wegner has also been visiting faculty for Bard College's Graduate Vocal Arts Program and is a frequent guest speaker at academic institutions, professional companies, and digital media outlets. She has presented at the NATS Winter Workshop and is an active member of Opera America.

**Douglas Sumi** is a frequent collaborator with many of today's artists and opera theaters. Having been engaged by Los Angeles Opera, Opera Theatre of St. Louis, and Wolf Trap Opera, among many other theaters, he has collaborated with legendary artists such as Renée Fleming, Plácido Domingo, Itzhak Perlman, Carol Vaness, and many of today's new opera stars like Angel Blue, Ailyn Pérez, and Janai Brugger. Currently, he is on faculty at Boston University's School of Music, teaching courses in song literature, lyric diction, and opera for pianists.
